On March 21 at approximately 5:53 am, Peru Police Officers responding to an unwanted guest at a residence located on North Benton Street, found themselves in an altercation inside the residence with 26 year-old Jeremiah J Mosley of Peru.

Mosley whom had been asked to leave the residence by the owner and police refused to do so. As police began to approach Mosley, he became more agitated and began to back himself into another part of the residence. As Officer began to get closer to Mosley, he then began to reach into his pocket as if he was reaching for some type of weapon.

Officers immediately grabbed a hold of Mosley at which time the altercation had began. Despite officers getting one handcuff on Mosley he continued to fight and try to reach into his pocket. Eventually Officers from the Peru Police Department and Miami County Sheriff Department were able to get Mosley subdued.

Officers then located a fully loaded 357 Magnum revolver in Mosley's right jacket pocket.

Mosley was placed under arrest and transported to Miami County Jail on a \$9,000 bond on the charges of, Possession of a Firearm Without a Permit, a

Class C Felony; Resisting Law Enforcement, Trespass and Possession of Stolen Property.

A 15 day hold was also placed on Mosley by the Miami County Probation Department
